Becky, Donnica and William doing an awesome job of training our editors for 20/21 school year... Welcome Stephanie, Star and Catherine.



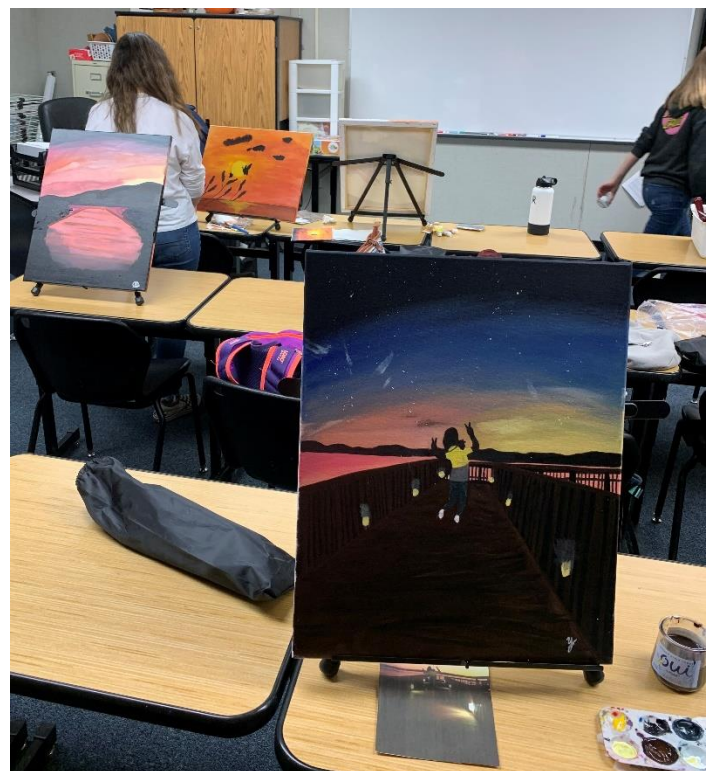
From Mrs. Hubert:

From Mrs. Kaufman:

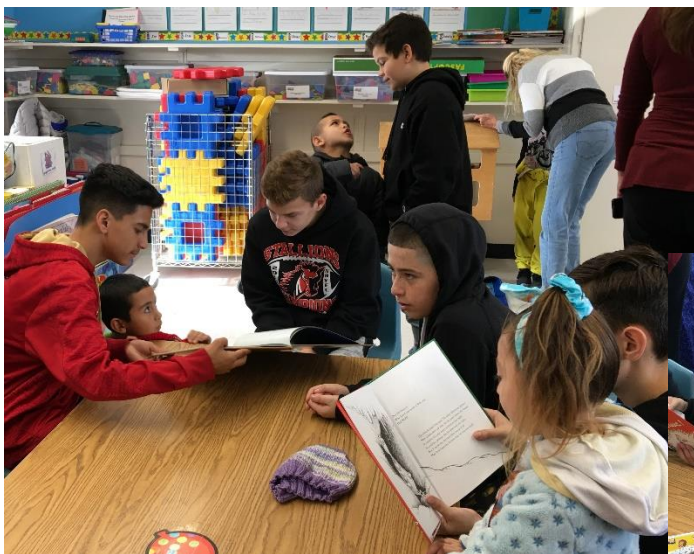
